

## Business & Technology Program: Accounting Concentration

Why should I major in Accounting? The Accounting Program provides students with a broad foundation in accounting procedures and theory in preparation for a career in the accounting field. The entire Business and Technology Program is accredited by the International Assembly for Collegiate Business Education (IACBE). Accreditation of the Business and Technology Program means that the courses, concentrations and majors are ranked as quality courses and programs by an outside over-sight group, and that the academic business program is functioning effectively (e.g., excellent student learning outcomes).

What type of degree will I earn at Grace University if I enroll in this program? Graduates of the Accounting Program will earn a Bachelor of Science degree.

What kind of jobs would be available to me after I graduate from Grace University with this major? Graduates of this program are encouraged to sit for the Certified Management Accountants exam or the Uniform C.P.A. Examination I Nebraska. The Uniform C.P.A. Examination includes additional course requirements beyond the 132 semester hours taken at Grace. Academic advisors at Grace will work closely with students who are considering certification options.
