

BS 204CC/BS 204DC - Gospels SYLLABUS

3 Hour or 4 Hour Course

Description

A study of the earthly life of Christ as revealed in the four Gospels. Attention is given to the political, religious, biblical, and geographical backgrounds. A chronology of events and a harmony of the Gospels are established. Biblical passages are analyzed. The character and purpose of the Gospels and the Person and ministry of Christ is analyzed.

Objectives

By taking this course the student will:

1. Understand the chronological sequence in Christ's life and ministry.
2. Comprehend how the Gospels harmonize chronologically.
3. Personally apply Scripture to life.
4. Develop Bible study skills.
5. Interpret Scripture from a literal grammatical approach.
