

PSY 300C ▪ Introduction to Biblical Counseling

SYLLABUS

3 Hour Course

Description

This course is designed to integrate Scripture, psychology and introductory counseling. The course focuses on the issues and problems of being a people-helper.

Objectives

By taking this course the student will:

1. Understand and articulate basic concepts of biblical counseling and pastoral counseling used by pastors and lay leaders in church ministry contexts.
2. Successfully complete the video training seminar and associated tests for Caring for People God's Way video produced by the Center for Biblical Counseling.
3. Establish protocols by which one maintains appropriate confidentiality, initiates appropriate referrals to other professionals, and discloses criminal behavior when prescribed by law.
4. Articulate a personal philosophy of counseling using Scripture.
5. Develop basic skills for collecting data, assessing and prioritizing client issues, and guiding an individual toward appropriate interventions and life changes associated with his or her issues.
