

TS 550C - Religions in America

SYLLABUS

3 Hour Course

Description

This course is a survey of religious groups that claim to be "Christian" but whose theological positions are inconsistent with orthodox Christianity. Historical data about each group and its religious roots as well as a systematic comparison of each group's doctrine as compared to Scripture are emphasized.

Objectives

By taking this course the student will:

1. Compare biblical Christianity with counterfeit religious groups and identify basic differences by practicing critical thinking.
2. Quote from memory verses of Scripture that defend key doctrines of biblical Christianity.
3. Use the library for scholarly research.
4. Distinguish primary sources from secondary sources in order to do the highest quality of documentation.
5. Use the Internet and computer sources for research.
6. Write logically and clearly, according to accepted writing style.
7. Make applications to life from the doctrines studied.

Learning Experiences

1. Reading *What They Believe, Encyclopedic Dictionary of Cults, Sects, and World Religions*, and *Handbook of Today's Religions* and answering questions related to the content of these books.
2. Short projects with the first two lessons allowing the student to express his/her testimony and other assignments in written form.
3. Research assignments that teach the student about the resources of the library and how to use its services, especially online sources.
4. Scripture memorization to fortify specific doctrines in order that the student might give a biblical defense of biblical Christianity.
5. Writing a research paper comparing several religions.
6. Writing two research papers, one on the Hindu Religion and one on Islam.
